Guidelines:

1. Must be a high school senior, graduating 2019.
2. High school seniors may apply to receive one of three scholarships:
 1. Public Power Scholarship (\$1,000)
 2. Powerline Program Scholarship (\$500)
 3. Telecommunications Scholarship (\$500)
3. The student, parent or legal guardian must be a customer of **Independence Light & Power, Telecommunications**. Dependents of utility personnel are also eligible.
4. Applicants for the **Public Power Scholarship** must plan to attend a two-year technical college or a four-year university. Applicants for the **Powerline Program Scholarship** must be a high school senior planning to attend an accredited Powerline Program. For the **Telecommunications Scholarship**, the high school senior must plan to attend a two year or four year education in technology.
5. Applicants will be judged on the following:
 - Academic achievement
 - Extracurricular achievement
 - Work and/or volunteer experience
 - Future career goals
6. Applications must be completed and submitted to the Independence Light & Power, Telecommunications utility office no later than February 25, 2019. The applications will then be sent to WPPI Energy and scored by the Scholarship Review Committee.
7. Awards will be announced at the regular Independence Light & Power, Telecommunications utility board meeting in May.
